- **Europe:** ACCA certified professionals are hired in Europe with good salary packages.
- **The United Kingdom and Ireland:** The ACCA or Chartered Certified Accountants issue permits, auditing, and other [investment business](#) work to individuals for conducting insolvency appointments as this qualification is fully recognized in both the United Kingdom and Ireland.
- **European Union (EU), European Economic Area (EEA) & Switzerland:** All the countries under the European Union wing have legally recognized this qualification.
- **Turkey:** In 2004, the Union of Chambers of Certified Public Accountants of Turkey was allowed to achieve ACCA membership by following the ACCA strategic professional level. They had signed a partnership agreement in the same year.
- **North America:** ACCA is a recognized qualification in North America.
- **United States:** ACCA is recognized in the United States of America but with some exceptions like in the case of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and National Association of State Boards of Accountancy.

ACCA has almost 2015 members in the US.

- **Canada:** There are 3011 ACCA members in Canada.
- ACCA is also recognized in Oceania, Australia, CA ANZ Strategic Alliance, New Zealand, Caribbean, Central and South America, Africa, Namibia, South Africa, Zimbabwe, Asia, China, Hong Kong, Macau, Malaysia, Nepal, Pakistan, Singapore, Taiwan, and United Arab Emirates.
