The International 9 (\$ 34.33 Million)

It is the largest Dota 2 eSports tournament in the world organized by the developer of this video game, Valve. It is this tournament that broke all records when it comes to the amount in prize funds in eSports tournaments. Even after 9 years (this year will be the 10th edition), the amount of the prize fund does not stop growing. This is happening to the delight of all competitors who are trying their best to win the title of the best.

Fortnite World Cup Finals 2019 (\$ 30.4 Million)

Did you know that the first Fortnite World Cup final had one of the biggest prize pools in the history of eSports? That is why we cannot help but mention it when it comes to eSports tournaments with the biggest prize funds.

According to numerous claims of experts, Fortnite did an incredible job thanks to a huge bonus that the organizers of other tournaments could only dream of. League of Legends World Championship 2018 (\$ 6.4 Million)

The best League of Legends (LoL) players do not even think of missing the World Championship, and it is clear why – precisely because of the prize fund. Back in 2017, Riot Games, the company that developed this video game, allowed its fans to increase the overall prize pool of the tournament by purchasing items. From that moment, the prize fund does not stop growing, and the largest amount was recorded in 2018: \$ 6.4 million made the World Championship in LoL the biggest event in the history of the game when it comes to the amount of money awarded.

Call of Duty World Championship (\$ 4.6 Million)

This, like many other eSports events, took place in the shadow of the coronavirus.

Although most of the introductory season of the Call of Duty (CoD) league was held online precisely because of the pandemic, the amount of the prize fund has doubled compared to 2019. As a result, it has become one of the largest prize funds in the history of eSports.

Fortnite Fall Skirmish Series (\$ 4 Million)

The worship of a [Fortnite video game](#) has reached its peak in recent years. It is for this reason that the prize pool for this event is growing.

Namely, \$ 100 million were intended for the funds of the Fortnite tournament, and a good part of that money went to the Fall Skirmish series of competitions.

Honor of Kings World Champion Cup 2020 (\$ 4.6 Million)

The coronavirus pandemic did not stop China, which organized the largest eSports tournament in history. Namely, at the Honor of Kings World Champions Cup, which was held in Beijing and Shanghai, 12 awesome teams competed for the prize, which amounted to \$ 4.6 million.

Wondering which are the eSports tournaments with the biggest prize pools? Well, this one is definitely one of them.

PUBG Global Championship 2019 (\$ 4 Million)

The oldest of the eSports really laid the foundations of its scene, followed by tournaments and numerous teams winning tournament after tournament.

One of the eSports tournaments with the largest prize fund is the PUBG Global Championship held in 2019. It was at this competition that the prize fund amounted to \$ 4 million and it is one of the largest prize funds in the history of eSports.

Dota 2 Asia Championship (\$ 3 Million)

This Dota 2 eSports tournament was held in Shanghai in 2015.

Although it seems that it should not attract the attention of eSports fans because it is a local competition, the amount of the prize fund should not be neglected: \$ 3 million is not a small thing.
