

New 'Smoking Gun' Photo Of Dead Alien Emerges

Whether it's a publicity stunt or not, never-before-seen photographs from the 1947's Roswell UFO crash depicting an alleged alien have emerged.

The images were presented at an event called *Be Witness* at the National Auditorium in Mexico City on Tuesday, May 5, 2015.

The topic, of course, is a controversial one, with official bodies such as NASA in the United States have never formally recognized alien life on planet Earth.

The pictures were reportedly taken by geologist Bernard A Ray, and are said to show the remains of an alien found dead in New Mexico between 1947 and 1949.

Richard Dolan, a leading researcher and writer on the subject of UFOs, argued that he believes that the photos are genuine:

"The analysis of the body or creature that is presented in the image, suggested that this is not a mummy, not a human, not a mammal and not a model, which would require a highly sophisticated detailed understanding of comparative anatomy among various species."

Edgar Mitchell, an astronaut who was the sixth person to land on the moon, attended the event, and was accompanied by a team of extraterrestrial investigators. They all claim the images are authentic and not doctored. UFO enthusiasts who were unable to attend the event followed the revelations via internet streaming.
