

Cover-up: More of Fluoride's Sordid Past Now Revealed

In 1997, Joel Griffiths and Chris Bryson, two respected mainstream journalists, peered into an abyss. They found a story about fluorides that was so chilling it had to be told. The Christian Science Monitor, who had assigned the story, never published it. Their ensuing article, "Fluoride, Teeth, and the Atomic Bomb," has been posted on websites, sometimes with distortions, deletions, or additions.
