Since the surface remains flush at the edges, you can swipe food crumbs and liquid spills into the sink in one shot. The absence of rim between worktop and sink also makes this set up look modern and sleek. And as you get to explore a variety of possibilities with the surface, you find it even more impressive. From cast iron, granite, and stainless steel, you can choose any of them to have an experience of the perfect undermount kitchen sink.

If you are a busy cook, who works with heavy and bulky pots, you can select a large, single basin in this design. Or, if you are a multitasking person, it makes sense to choose a double basin fixture.

## The installation options with undermount fitting

There can be a threat to structural integrity in the end. Hence, it is necessary to know what its installation process involves. Awareness can help you avoid risks and have the perfect setup in your kitchen. So, it goes like this:

- Different support systems are available for this sink.
  You need to choose one of them.
- After this, you have to install a pan on the supporting frame.
- The caulking has to be good. It would go around the edge of the sink's top.
- When done, you can go ahead with the installation of the nearby worktops. The bowl will sit between the countertop and the cabinet frame.

If you have a concrete countertop, you need to ensure that the whole weight of the sink doesn't fall on it. It can crack the worktop. A proper support system has to be there to handle the matter. The supporting frame will share the weight with the concrete to ensure safe installation. You get three choices in support systems, including commercial brackets, custom wooden frames, and customized plywood shelf.

Several brands and online stores sell brackets with sinks to make your installation experience easy and hassle-free. Wood frames, on the other hand, sit on the walls of your cabinet to carry some weight of the sink. In the case of a plywood shelf, a thick plywood sheet goes inside the cabinetry. The plywood has a hole in which the sink settles down. The hole has to be considerable in size to ensure the correct alignment of the

tub.
